**THAT**, aware that, the Physical Planning Act, provides under section 32(3) that when a development application is considered, regard must be accorded to the health, amenities and conveniences of the community generally and to the proper planning and density of development and land use in the area; Deeply concerned that a large number of buildings around the County have erroneously been erected without proper lighting, thus posing a security risk to the residents; this Assembly therefore urges the County Government to put in place measures to ensure that all approvals for building plans incorporate the requirement for the installation of security lights, as well as to ensure that the installation of security lights is provided for in existing commercial buildings.
